Applications close: October 4, 2026.

Purpose

The program aims to recognize and support professionals from Latin America and the Caribbean with an outstanding academic record and a project idea with the potential to generate value in their professional, institutional, business, social, environmental, cultural, or community contexts.

The scholarship aims to strengthen participants' capacity to formulate, plan, execute, and manage projects through graduate studies in the Master's Degree in Project Management at the University for International Cooperation.

Benefits

- 6 partial scholarships available
- 25% waiver of the enrollment fee (equivalent to USD 135)
- 60% tuition waiver throughout the program (equivalent to USD 4,040)

Scholarships do not cover graduation fees, optional external certifications, PMI membership, or other related administrative costs.

Who can apply? - Applicant profile

Eligible applicants must:

- Hold residency in a country in Latin America or the Caribbean.
- Hold a university degree that meets the admission requirements for the Master's Degree in Project Management.
- Have a minimum academic average equivalent to 80 out of 100.
- Submit a project idea they wish to develop or strengthen during their studies.
- Be interested in applying project management in their professional field, organization, community, institution, or economic sector.

Application requirements

Applicants must:

1. Meet the admission requirements for the Master's Degree in Project Management.
2. Provide an official transcript of grades from their university degree program indicating:
 - Final academic average.
 - Grading scale used.
 - Maximum possible grade.
3. Submit a project proposal of no more than three pages, including:
 - Name of the project or project idea.
 - Problem, need, or opportunity the project seeks to address.
 - Rationale and importance of the proposal.
 - Overall objective of the project.
 - Potential beneficiaries, including individuals, organizations, communities, or sectors.
 - Expected results or benefits.
 - How the Master's Degree in Project Management will contribute to the development, planning, or implementation of the proposal.

The project idea may be at the conceptual, planning, or implementation stage. If the project is already underway, applicants may optionally attach links or supporting documents that provide additional information.

Evaluation criteria

Applications will be evaluated by an academic committee based on the following weighting: 70% academic merit and 30% project idea.

Please note that scholarship awards are subject to applicants meeting the program's admission requirements and to the results of the evaluation process.

How to apply - Application procedure

- **Step 1.** Check that you meet the applicant profile and admission requirements for the master's program you wish to apply to.
- **Step 2.** Complete the UCI admission process with your admissions counselor and submit the required documentation.

- **Step 4.** Await the evaluation of your application and the official notification of results according to the schedule below.
